

2013 Federal Poverty Guidelines 135

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The Federal Register notice of the 2013 poverty guidelines is available. The poverty guidelines are sometimes loosely referred to as the “federal poverty level” (FPL), but that phrase is ambiguous and should be avoided, especially in situations (e.g., legislative or administrative) where precision is important.

The 2013 Federal Poverty Level (FPL) Guidelines determine the income level requirements for people applying for the Low Income Subsidy (LIS) program. For the remainder of 2013, if your income is below 135% of the FPL (\$15,511.50 if you are single or \$20,938.50 for married couples), you could qualify for the full Low Income Subsidy (resource ...

Consumers may qualify for the Lifeline Program if they participate in a qualifying program or have a gross household income at or below 135 percent of the federal poverty guidelines. The table below reflects 135% of the 2020 Federal Poverty Guidelines (FPG).

2020 Federal Poverty Guidelines Chart . The HHS Department issues poverty guidelines for each household size. For example, the poverty level for a household of four in 2020 is an annual income of \$26,200. To get the poverty level for larger families, add \$4,480 for each additional person in the household.

As a point of reference, at the time of this writing, the annual FPL for a household of one is \$12,760 (\$1,063 / month), and the maximum annual SSI benefit amount for a single individual is \$9,396 (\$783 / month). As with the FPL, many assistance programs use SSI figures to determine if an applicant is income eligible.

HHS issues poverty guidelines in late January of each year. Some programs make them effective on date of publication, others at a later date. For example, the 2013 poverty guidelines were issued in January 2013, calculated from the calendar year 2011 thresholds issued in September 2012, updated to reflect the price level of calendar year 2012.

What Are Poverty Thresholds And Poverty Guidelines ...

If you are looking for the monthly poverty levels – for determining Medicaid eligibility for instance – divide the annual

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number by the number of months you are trying to calculate (or see our 6 month and monthly charts below). (i.e., For 2013 100% of the FPL for one person was \$11,490.
