Slide the pinion shaft out toward you and remove it. Push the wheel flanges straight in. Remove the C-clips of the flanges and pull the rear axle shaft straight out of its housing.

Skip the trip to the mechanic - this bearing puller makes it easy to remove semi-floating rear axle bearings. Choose from three different sizes to fit the main bearing tube ID: 1 in. to 1-7/8 in., 1-5/16 in. to 2-3/8 in., or 1-3/8 in. to 2-7/8 in.. Constructed from heavy duty cast steel, this bearing puller set works on most

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domestic cars.

Jacking Up the Rear End. There's one correct way to lift the rear end of a truck using the spare tire jack. Place the jack underneath the rear axle on either side. Lift the truck by lifting the rear axle. Then, support the vehicle by placing jack stands underneath the frame rail. Repeat this on the other side of the vehicle. Figure 3.

Park the F-150 on a level, paved surface and set the parking brake. Place wheel chocks in front of the front wheels. Loosen the lug nuts on the rear wheels. Raise the F-150 with a jack and support it with jack stands. Remove the lug nuts and wheels.

Determining what type of limited-slip rear axle a Ford F-150 has can be accomplished two ways. After 1968, Ford cars and trucks have an axle code on a "Certification Plate," located on the driver's door. Ford rear axles also have an identification tag located on the rear axle itself.

Everything I've read shows the Ranger includes Ford's standard trac-lok limited slip rear diff as standard on rear axles (and front for 4x4). The e-locker is of course optional. The limited slip in my Dakota is very tight and never had an issue where a locker would have made the difference somewhere.

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
