Repair of disrupted ligaments to the periosteum or with osseous suture anchors is performed in markedly unstable situations. With stable constructs, hinged elbow braces are used to gradually regain flexion—extension while avoiding varus—valgus stress. However, it may be necessary to immobilize in a long arm until sufficient bony healing if the fixation or vascularity of the fragments is precarious.

Stable lesions can be treated with rest, whereas unstable lesions, as well as stable lesions that do not respond to nonoperative therapy, may require a surgical approach. Magnetic resonance imaging is the diagnostic study of choice to evaluate capitellar osteochondral lesions and loose bodies and to accurately determine the stability and viability of the fragment so that the appropriate treatment can be initiated.
